



## Public Usage

*Sahalie Ski Lodge* is a **unique** and **affordable** retreat opportunity. The Lodge is available to groups on most weekends and weekdays during the late spring, summer and fall, and on winter days when it is not being used by club members.

Groups may contract with *Sahalie Ski Club* to have exclusive use of the entire 14,500 square foot facility at a reasonable cost.

Our rustic mountain lodge has three fireplaces, meeting and dining rooms, dormitory-style sleeping arrangements, a large commercial kitchen, showers and easy access to the skiing, hiking and biking facilities of the Snoqualmie Summit area. It has a low key, warm and inviting environment that encourages camaraderie.

*Sahalie Lodge* has successfully hosted corporate retreats, wedding receptions, family reunions, mountain biking excursions, holiday parties and youth functions. Only 55 minutes from downtown Seattle, the Lodge feels remote but is actually close to the freeway, stores and services. Experience a bit of history in the oldest continuously operated ski club lodge in the State of Washington.

## Rates

The Base Rate for overnight is \$2,000.00 for the first 24 hours. Add \$1,200.00 for each consecutive day thereafter. (Multiple day discounts may apply) This fee includes use for up to 50 guests, the daily Lodge Manager fee, access to all dishes, glassware, and cooking utensils, commissary supplies, firewood and lodge cleaning.

Payment details:

- \$300.00 non-refundable deposit is due at time of booking, and will be applied to invoice. A refundable damage deposit of \$350.00, made by a credit card, is also required.

- 50% deposit is due 30 days prior to your Retreat with the balance due 14 days prior.

Additional charges apply for guests exceeding 50 in number (for a total max. occupancy of 120 people for day rentals and 90 for overnight rentals).
